Principle Responsibilities:	To identify, recruit and handle relevant Counter Terrorism and Extreme Left and Right Wing CHIS to provide information impacting on National Security and other priorities relevant to CTP SE activities.
	Task authorised CHIS as required to obtain specific information ensuring that the relevant conditions and RIPA/ECHR requirements are adhered to and that the integrity of the Department is maintained at all times.
	Provide advice, guidance and immediate professional assistance to other officers and staff when required.
	To conduct intelligence debriefs as required by the DSU Controller, to ensure a co-ordinated and strategic approach to intelligence gathering.
	Together with other colleagues within the Dedicated Source Unit, engage and develop awareness of procedures, legislation and national requirements regarding CT/DE CHIS.
	To complete accurate reports on the activity undertaken and information gleaned ensuring that they are disseminated to the correct organisations/teams and individuals.
	Ensure on a day-to-day basis the security of all information obtained follows the correct protocols in order to mitigate the risk of compromise.
	To be part of a Regional DSU on Call Cadre that may include duties outside of DSU at times of demand.
	To respond to terrorist incidents across the UK as part of a National CTP resource.
	To attend and pass the relevant national handling courses that will enable you to perform the role of source handler. ENDS
