

## **English and Maths qualifications**

**GCSEs (grade 9-4/A-C) or one of the below equivalent qualifications in English and Maths are required for this role**, regardless of any higher qualifications attained in other subjects/fields. You will be required to bring along the original certificates to interview so that a member of the interview panel can verify and take a copy for our records. You therefore may wish to start requesting these documents in advance to avoid delay later on in the process.
