Purpose of role:	<p>To ensure the JOU remains fully compliant with all conditions of the Firearms Training Licence issued by The College of Policing</p> <p>To ensure that a full training plan is developed for all different firearms department that is fully compliant with the National Police Firearms Training Curriculum and JOU STRA</p> <p>Development of all Firearms Training to ensure the JOU's capability is enhanced in line with local and national requirements</p>
Principle Responsibilities:	1. Maintain the required standards to ensure that the firearms training licence is fully compliant with the standards required by The College of Policing.
	2. Ensure that all JOU Firearms Role Profiles are current and relevant in relation to the NPFTC and JOU STRA.
	3. Design and publish a comprehensive training plan for all firearms departments.
	4. To maintain qualification as a Tactical Advisor and/or Tactical Firearms Commander.
	5. To develop the training team and ensure that the department is kept in an operational ready state to support any operational deployments as required.
	6. To advise JOU SMT were appropriate on all firearms matters that may be impacted upon by the NPFTC and Licence conditions.
	7. Be responsible for the implementation of Health and Safety legislation.
	8. Represent the JOU at local, regional and national meetings as required.
Essential role based training:	The post holder will be required to become a Tactical Advisor and Tactical Firearms Commander if not already qualified.
Essential Training Prior to Appointment:	The holder must hold a National Firearms Instructor qualification
