Role Title:	Police Constable - Surveillance	Department:	Counter Terrorism Policing South East (CTP SE)
Reports To:	Detective Sergeant - Surveillance	Location:	South East Region

Purpose of role:	To undertake covert, mobile, technical and foot surveillance in order to obtain intelligence and evidence to assist an investigation or operation.
Principle Responsibilities:	Undertake covert surveillance as authorised under the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 200, and Human Rights legislation.
	Debrief covert surveillance operations on a daily basis, ensuring the evidential log is accurate.
	Develop self and colleagues by constructive assessment of effectiveness on operations undertaken, identifying both positive and negative performance.
	Comply with the constraints imposed by relevant legislation and National policies in particular RIPA 200, Security Service Act 1989, ACPO Surveillance Manual and Human Rights Act.
