Role Title:	Police Constable/Detective Constable – Counter Terrorism (CT) Border Policing - Ports Officer	Department:	Borders Policing, Counter Terrorism Policing South East (CTPSE)

Purpose of role:	<p>CTBP officers are at the front line of protecting national security from the threats posed by Terrorism and Serious & Organised Crime at the borders and ports of Hampshire, Thames Valley, Surrey and Sussex. On occasion officers are also deployed to support our colleagues across the CTPSE region.</p> <p>Ports officers are tasked to manage the known and unknown threats posed by individuals and groups seeking to travel across borders in furtherance of terrorism and serious organised crime. The role is intrinsic to the UK Counter Terrorism Strategy and supporting the British Intelligence Services in mitigating the threat to UK interests at home and abroad.</p>
Principle Responsibilities:	Undertake examination of persons using Schedule 7 Terrorism Act 2000.
	Gather quality intelligence both in relation to Terrorism, extremism and serious and organised crime.
	Dissemination of intelligence to partner agencies to enable the process of further investigation.
	Detect and seize cash from persons involved or suspected to be involved in terrorism or criminal activity
	Undertake tasking relating to priority CT investigations under the direction of a CT SIO.
	Respond to alerts generated by the National Border Targeting Centre (NBTC) and PNC Markers.
	Support to CT safeguarding issues, child abduction and family court matters.
	Establish close working relationships with key partner agencies and provide the highest quality of service.
	Proactively police the UK border in partnership with UK Border Force, NCA and local Police.

Essential role based training:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The posts are open to all Constables who are willing and able to undertake an accreditation process including a pass or fail exam.
Essential Criteria:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possess strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate effectively with a wide range of partner agencies and members of the travelling public. You will work within an international airport, international ferry port, other portal areas and deal with persons from all over the world. (Essential) Effective report writing skills; the post holder will prepare detailed reports for a wide range of law enforcement and intelligence partners both domestic and overseas. (Essential) High levels of self-motivation, initiative and ability to work with limited supervision. (Essential) Good investigative and interviewing skills (Essential)
