CONSTABLE ROLE SPECIFICATION

Role Title:	Detective Constable - Counter Terrorism Exhibit Officer and Scene Investigator	Department:	Counter Terrorism Policing South East (CTP SE)
Reports To:	Detective Sergeant FMT	Location:	Near Junction 12, M4 Berkshire

Purpose of role:	Implement strategies to service the needs of highly sensitive, covert and overt Counter Terrorism (CT) operations. Manage covert and overt exhibits in support of Counter Terrorism Policing South East (CTPSE) investigations.
Principle Responsibilities:	1. Attend terrorism-related incidents such as exploded and unexploded bomb or CBRN scenes. Take responsibility as a scene investigator for the effective management of such incidents. Give professional advice on examinations of the related premises, vehicles and locations ensuring that the forensic strategy set by the CTSIO is delivered.
	2. Be responsible on behalf of the CTSIO for the management of all exhibits generated within a counter terrorist investigation including exhibit handling, scene management, scene investigation, submission of exhibits and liaison with external forensic suppliers/external experts.
	3. Evaluate the scene/incident and maximise the opportunity to collect and gather intelligence and evidence from a range of sources that are appropriate to the serious and complex nature of the investigation. Record and retain evidence in a format that is evidentially admissible to support the investigative process.
	4. Undertake scene examination techniques including explosive and firearms trace work and digital photography in order to ensure evidence and intelligence is recovered effectively as part of a counter terrorism investigation.
	5. At a practitioner level to take control and represent the regional Counter Terrorism Unit at hazardous, Disaster Victim Identification (DVI) and Chemical Biological, Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) incidents.
	6. Deliver hospital and mortuary liaison including the recovery of exhibits from casualty-receiving hospitals and those recovered from injured or deceased persons, assisting HM Coroner as directed and acting as a point of contact between hospitals, the Coroner and the Police.

Essential Criteria:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successfully completed the initial or foundation CID training course. • Successfully completed the National Terrorist FMT course or be willing and able to undertake the course. • Proven investigative experience relating to major or serious and organised crime, including working within a Major Incident Room/HOLMES environment. • Proven experience in the co-ordination and management of complex scenes, and experience of exhibit handling using HOLMES 2 Exhibits and experience of inter-agency liaison. • Knowledge of issues relating to CBRN. Willingness and ability to conduct CBRN training and CBRN activities, including working in unpleasant and contaminated environments. • Holder of a full UK driving licence, able to travel and work in any area in the south east region or CT network, possibly for extended periods. Willing and able to work unsociable hours, provide 24 hour cover, to change hours at short notice and participate in call-out rota.
